The Inn at the Presidio, San Francisco, CA

A one-time military barracks turned boutique hotel, this 22-room property has come a long way since housing unmarried officers when San Francisco's Presidio was an Army base. Built in 1903, the Georgian Revival-style building is tucked into the area's protected parkland at the Golden Gate with stunning views of the San Francisco Bay. [The comfortable accommodations](#), spread out between the main house and a smaller Victorian-style guest house, nicely blend contemporary touches with historic accents. Take a romantic hike along Lover's Lane, then get cozy around the fire pit with a glass of vino from nearby [wine country](#). Bonus: it's next door to the popular and [picturesque Presidio Chapel of Our Lady](#) so newlyweds can literally stroll on over after saying their "I Dos."
